Tai Ceredigion goes live

The transfer of Ceredigion Council's homes to Tai Ceredigion has officially taken place on 30 November.

The transfer followed a major consultation exercise undertaken by the Council which resulted in tenants backing the plan in a ballot last year.

Hag Harris, Chair of the Board of Tai Ceredigion said: "The hard work starts now. Tenants have placed a great deal of trust in us and we will keep every promise that has been made. We have started delivering the housing service and in the New Year will be announcing more detailed plans for the delivery of the £40m programme of improvements to homes over the next five years. These are exciting times for all concerned."

The new not for profit housing association is responsible for the management of over 2,300 homes, 140 leasehold dwellings and employs over 100 members of staff.
